*After tasting nearly 200 cuvées, here are the 15 champagnes offering the best value for money based on the scores awarded by our tasters.*

*More than for any other wine, the question of value for money arises with champagne. Due to its demanding production specifications and prestige, in particular, the most famous of sparkling wines has a specific price range, which is in any case higher than its non-sparkling cousins. Unfortunately, this does not always correspond to the quality once the drink is served in the glass. Based on our extensive tasting of almost 200 cuvées, this selection offers champagnes that are excellent value for money, i.e., wines with the highest balance between retail price and our tasters' scores...*
